INFORMATION CLAUSE ON THE PROCESSING OF PERSONAL DATA

Identity of the Controller

Wrocław University of Science and Technology, located at Wybrzeże Stanisława Wyspiańskiego 27, Wrocław, is the controller deciding on the purposes and methods of processing personal data. You can contact the controller via the contact form and details provided at www.pwr.edu.pl/kontakt or in writing to the University's address. The controller has appointed a Data Protection Officer (DPO), who can be contacted at IOD@pwr.edu.pl. For matters related to exercising your data subject rights, please contact phobia@pwr.edu.pl.

Purposes and Legal Basis for Processing

Your personal data are processed by the controller for the following purposes:

- 1. Preparing, organizing, and conducting the 7th International Scientific Photography Contest "Microscopic Art Non-limited International Annual Contest MANIAC 2025," in accordance with the Contest Rules accepted by the Participant when submitting the online entry, under Article 6(1)(b) of the GDPR;
- 2. Documenting the event, processing prize payments, and fulfilling archiving obligations regarding proper documentation, according to Article 6(1)(c) of the GDPR;
- 3. Contacting you (including via private email addresses) to provide information, decisions, and notices from the controller, and to send you offers related to your status, where necessary for the legitimate interests pursued by the controller (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR). The use of student email accounts is governed by separate internal university regulations.
- 4. Public sharing of participants' image (e.g., photos from the event or pictures submitted by winners) in promotional and informational materials related to the Contest, in particular on the University's website and social media solely based on the participant's voluntary consent, according to Article 6(1)(a) of the GDPR.

The University may need to contact you using identifying and contact details (including private email addresses) other than those provided for the duration of your studies.

Data Recipients or Categories of Recipients

Your personal data may be disclosed to entities cooperating with the University, including government bodies (particularly the Ministry of Science and Higher Education) and other institutions involved in the implementation of public tasks.

Data recipients may also include sponsors and institutions funding or co-funding initiatives or projects run by the controller. These institutions may require reports on the controller's activities, including cooperation with external entities. Your data may also be made available to auditors and entities supervising the controller's activities based on the law or contracts concluded by the controller.

Data may also be shared with other entities to whom the controller outsources specific tasks requiring data processing, such as IT, archiving, document storage and destruction services, property and personnel protection, postal and courier services, or transportation services. The University processes personal data using IT systems, databases, hardware, and software. The controller concludes data processing agreements with such entities for external processing centers.

Data Retention Period

Data will be retained for the period necessary to fulfill the purposes mentioned above, including:

- for processing related to the performance of contracts with various entities (including sponsorship agreements) — for the duration of such contracts (if applicable);

- for processing based on legal obligations of the controller — for the period specified in the Uniform File Classification of Wrocław University of Science and Technology;

- for processing based on the legitimate interests of the controller (Article 6(1)(f) of the GDPR) — only for the period necessary to maintain communication with the participant before and after the Contest.

Data Subject Rights

You have the right to access your data and request its rectification. You may also exercise your right to restrict processing, data portability, and object to processing.

Right to Lodge a Complaint

You have the right to lodge a complaint with a supervisory authority for data protection in your country of residence, place of work, or where the alleged violation occurred. In Poland, this is the President of the Personal Data Protection Office (PUODO).

Voluntary or Mandatory Provision of Data

The provision of your personal data is necessary to organize the 7th International Scientific Photography Contest MANIAC 2025, conduct the contest procedures in accordance with the Contest Rules, and maintain communication with you (including electronically). Failure to provide data will prevent your participation in the 7th International Scientific Photography
